

Cookie Policy (EU)

This Cookie Policy was last updated on 15 September 2026 and applies to citizens and legal permanent residents of the European Economic Area and Switzerland.

1. Introduction

Our website, <https://www.unipol.fi/> (hereinafter referred to as the “website”), uses cookies and other related technologies (for convenience, all technologies are referred to as “cookies”). Cookies are also placed by third parties with whom we cooperate. This document explains the cookies used on our website.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small, simple file that is sent along with pages of this website and stored by your browser on the hard drive of your computer or another device. The information stored in it may be returned to our servers or to the servers of the relevant third parties during a subsequent visit.

3. What are scripts?

A script is a piece of programming code that enables our website to function properly and interactively. This code is executed either on our server or on your device.

4. What is a web beacon?

A web beacon (or pixel tag) is a small, invisible piece of text or an image on a website that is used to monitor website traffic. Various data about you is stored using web beacons for this purpose.

5. Cookies

5.1 Technical or functional cookies

Some cookies ensure that certain parts of the website function properly and that your user preferences remain known. By placing functional cookies, we make it easier for you to visit our website. This means you do not need to enter the same information repeatedly when visiting our website.

5.2 Statistics cookies

We use statistics cookies to optimise the website experience for our users. These statistics cookies provide us with information about how our website is used. We ask for your permission to place statistics cookies.

5.3 Marketing/tracking cookies

Marketing/tracking cookies are cookies or any other form of local storage used to create user profiles for displaying advertising or to track the user on this website or across several websites for similar marketing purposes.

6. Consent

When you visit our website for the first time, you will see a pop-up containing information about cookies. When you click “Save preferences”, you consent to our use of the cookies and plug-ins you selected in the pop-up, as described in this Cookie Policy. You can disable cookies through your browser, but please note that our website may no longer function properly as a result.

7. Enabling, disabling and deleting cookies

You can use your internet browser to delete cookies automatically or manually. You can also specify that certain cookies may not be placed. Another option is to change your internet browser settings so that you receive a notification whenever a cookie is placed. For more information about these options, please refer to the instructions in your browser's Help section.

Please note that our website may not function properly if all cookies are disabled. If you delete cookies from your browser, they will be placed again with your consent when you revisit our website.

8. Your rights regarding personal data

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- You have the right to know why your personal data is needed, what will happen to it and how long it will be retained.
- Right of access: You have the right to access the personal data we hold about you.
- Right to rectification: You have the right to supplement, correct, delete or block your personal data at any time.
- If you consent to our processing of your data, you have the right to withdraw that consent and request the deletion of your personal data.
- Right to data portability: You have the right to request all your personal data from the controller and transfer it in full to another controller.
- Right to object: You may object to the processing of your data. We will comply with your request unless there are justified grounds for the processing.

If you have a complaint about how we handle your data, we would like to hear from you. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (the data protection authority).
